



Crew Descriptions



FULL-TIME CREWS

(Committed to the entire 24HR period)

Cast Member - Volunteers must submit a video audition to be considered for this team. Cast Members learn their role when the musical is announced on August 6th. They will spend the 24HR period learning and rehearsing their lines, blocking, music, and choreography. For audition guidelines, please view the "Audition Details" document.

Set or Props - Members of these teams will be creating the show's set and props during the 24HR period! They may also be backstage during the performance, helping move set and prop pieces. Painting and building skills are a plus but not required. Must be okay with using scissors, hot glue guns, power tools, etc.

Costumes - Members of this team will be finding or making the actor's costumes during the 24HR period! Hand sewing/sewing machine skills are a plus but not required. Must be okay with using scissors, needles, sewing machines, hot glue guns, etc.

Backstage - Members of this team will keep the show running smoothly from behind the scenes! Much of the 24HR period will be spent keeping rehearsals on track, learning which characters/costumes/set pieces/props/mics are needed for each scene, and coordinating between the various teams. During the performance, this team will be backstage changing microphones, moving the set, and prompting actors.

Tech - Members of this team will be practicing cues for lighting/ music/microphones during the 24HR period, learning the show and characters, and finding any necessary sound effects. During the performance, they'll be in the sound booth running the technical side of the show!

Social Media - This team will be updating the world on our progress during the 24HR Period! They will post pictures and videos of rehearsals, document the craziness that will ensue, conduct interviews with cast and team members, and remind everyone to get their tickets for the upcoming performance.

"Runner" - Runners are a team that can handle anything! They must be adults (21+ with a car) who can drive to get things as needed, monitor the eating/napping areas, and generally help things run smoothly during the 24HR period.

PART-TIME CREWS

(Available for parts of the 24HR period... 18+ only)

Food Teams - These wonderful teams handle food deliveries and handout for the hungry and exhausted 24HR crews! From meals to snacks to lots of coffee, these folks give the volunteers the energy they'll need to keep going. We'll need team members for breakfast, lunch, and dinner on Saturday August 5th.

Check In – A lot of volunteers will be arriving on Friday August 4th, and this team helps check the volunteers in, give directions, and deal with paperwork.

Set Up or "Strike" Teams - These teams help us "set up" the church on August 4th and put it back ("strike") once the performance is done on August 5th. If available at other times, these teams could also help with cleanup as the Set/Prop/Costume teams finish up their work.

Parking or Box Office Teams - These teams arrive a few hours before the performance to help coordinate parking as the audience arrives or to check people's tickets and hand out programs.
